Guideline for Submission of Manuscripts

Submissions should conform to the APA 7th edition with critical sections including title, author(s) name, affiliation, phone number and email address as well as abstract of not more than 200 words.

Following the abstract, a minimum of 5 keywords that will provide indexing references should be listed.
